Nothing says ultimate pad like a palace in the sky. This quintet of crown jewels atop Miami's most exclusive addresses make a case for condo living with top-notch design, tantalizing trappings and amenities that make staying in a pleasure.



PRIME PAD What does \$35 million buy these days at 57 Ocean? The list is long. The deluxe digs at this Arguitectonica tower on Millionaire's Row live up to their location with 7,500 square feet of indoor space and almost just as much (7,000 square feet) of alfresco areas. Inside, the master living room was created with entertaining in mind as it features a gour met chef's kitchen and a sculptural wine cellar, plus a hidden prep kitchen with all the necessary amenities for the perfect gathering. WATERSIDE WONDER When considering the approach for Monad Terrace, Pritzker Prize-winning architect Jean Nouvel's only residential project in Florida, the man was intent on artfully directing the play of daylight and water throughout the tower. That vision is on display in Monad's marquee \$14 million Penthouse B. The residence spans two floors and features the largest in-residence high-rise pool in Miami Beach. Private elevator access into the 13,922-square-foot unit quickly reveals unique aspects such as a Nouvel-designed kitchen, five bedrooms and 5 ½ baths with marble, custom cabinetry, all sorts of built-in features and oak flooring throughout. A summer kitchen and 7,697 square feet of outdoor space complete the experience. As for the light? The price tag buys you five bedrooms, 6 ½ bathrooms and a rooftop terrace with a private pool. Floor-to-ceiling windows frame the Atlantic Ocean from just about every spot in this perch, while multiple expansive terraces beckon outdoor moments. Premium European cabinetry and Sub-Zero and Wolf appliances are common in the pad's kitchen. Furthermore, the his and her baths in the master suite are fitted with Armani sink features and spa-inspired showers. INTO THE GROVE Coconut Grove's renaissance is imminent, and pushing that along is **One Park Grove**, the final tower in the residential enclave that also includes Two Park Grove and Club Residences. Here, a 5,901-square-foot penthouse for \$12.5 million offers five bedrooms, five baths and a powder room, as well as postcard-perfect views of Biscayne Bay thanks to the multitude of 12-foot floor-to-ceiling windows and doors. The residence boasts various oversized waterfront terraces, an expansive dining and entertaining area, a master bedroom with his and her bathrooms and en suite baths in the other bedrooms. The chef's kitchen includes the requisite Wolf and Sub-Zero appliances, while the baths are all designed by William Sofield. Downstairs from all this are 4 acres of private gardens from Enzo Enea, 500 feet of bayfront pools and a private art gallery with works from masters from all around the world. *2821 S.
