## Cipriani plans first ground-up residences

Miami's Brickell neighborhood has been good to <u>Cipriani</u>: After opening a restaurant in 2013 and the Socialista lounge in 2019, the financial district will be home to the company's first-ever ground-up residence in the U.S.

Developed in partnership with Mast Capital, the Arquitectonica-designed <u>Cipriani Residences Miami</u> will soar 80 stories, offer residents floor-to-ceiling glass windows with unfettered views of Biscayne Bay and Simpson Park.

And, of course, residents will have exclusive access to Cipriani's classic Italian cuisine, available in-home, at private dining rooms, or on the building's resort deck.

"Miami has evolved tremendously, attracting culture, business, and entertainment, and guarantees an enviable quality of life," third-generation Cipriani CEO Giuseppe Cipriani told *Forbes*. "It is becoming a first or second residence for an increasing number of demanding and traveled individuals and families."

Construction is expected to be completed at the end of 2025.
